

**SKUSA Spring Nationals Rounds 3&4 COVID-19 Protocol, and Guidelines
As of May 6, 2021**

To SKUSA racers, supporters and staff,

We are all very excited to be able to host and participate in the 2021 SuperkartsUSA ProTour Event in Erda, Utah. First and foremost, we would like to thank you for attending our event during these unprecedented times. Our number one priority during these challenging times is to ensure the safety of our participants, staff, customers, and teams. To keep everyone safe during our event, **face coverings or masks will be recommended when out of your personal pit space**. These recommendations are to comply with the CDC, OSHA, and federal guidelines.

Here are the mandatory precautionary measures SKUSA is taking to ensure the safety of its staff, teams, and participants.

Overall, SKUSA will be:

- **Recommending that face coverings or masks be worn in the following areas: when leaving your pit space, registration, tech, scales, grid, and where social distancing is more difficult.**
- Implementing social distancing (of 6 ft or more) in common areas (with signs and ground stickers posted as friendly reminders)
- Roping off individual sections of the grandstand to ensure social distancing
- Providing a direct line of communication between team principals and race director
- Providing hand sanitizer, paper towels, and cleaning supplies in every department
- Providing SKUSA masks or disposable masks for any attendee that needs or would like one
- ALL entries will be made aware of these guidelines thru electronic notice and/or upon receiving their registration package

In the Registration Building:

- Masks will be recommended
- Grab & Go driver packets will be available and ready to pick up at check-in
- We will not be putting the wristband physically on you; please put it on yourself
- We will have everyone insert/remove their credit cards out of our machines, and we will not pass cards back and forth
- Everyone will be mandated to fill out a COVID questionnaire and waiver at check-in

In SKUSA Race Departments:

- Masks will be recommended in the following areas:
 - Tech
 - Scales
 - Grid
 - Race Control
 - Penalty box
 - Tires
- Masks will be recommended when speaking with any SKUSA official
- Only one mechanic or parent is allowed per driver in scales, tech, and grid
- The grid will remain a no spectator area
- We will not allow large groups to form around these areas
- We will have tape/stickers on the ground in high traffic areas to ensure appropriate space between participants

Pit assignments:

- Each pit assignment has been assigned and adheres to the following guidelines:
 - One race entry per designated 280sq/ft to position and maintain their kart, mechanic, and tools required to race
 - Ensure a 7-foot separation for each entry and work involved with the car

- Each team wearing the same representing team shirt is considered as "part of their immediate race family" and assumes this responsibility as such

Restroom accommodations:

- We have 10 full-service restrooms within the kart paddock (individual & full restroom facilities with running water and proper wash stations)
- Every bathroom has an ADA stall
- Restrooms and wash stations will be arranged following social distancing guidelines

ATTENTION: International travelers!

- You will need to get tested no more than 3 days (72 hours) before you travel by air into the United States (US) and be prepared to show your **negative** results to the airline before you board your flight -- or be prepared to show documentation of recovery (proof of a recent positive viral test and a letter from your healthcare provider or a public health official stating that you were cleared to travel).
- Individuals with known or suspected COVID-19 virus, or Individuals who have had close contact with a person with COVID-19 (i.e., who are considered exposed to COVID-19), should self-isolate and **NOT travel** until they have met CDC's [criteria for discontinuing isolation](#).
- Before entering the event, everyone will be screened by UMC officials and mandated to complete a COVID-19 questionnaire. If you have any symptoms of the virus – or fail to complete the questionnaire to the officials' satisfaction – you will be denied access and required to vacate the property immediately.

We want to continue to have these races while staying safe and healthy. We ask that you continue to respect the safety and well-being of others. We at SKUSA have worked extremely hard to make this race possible, and we thank you for your ongoing understanding, business, and support during these times.

COVID-19 Waiver of Liability

As most people are aware, the United States and most other countries are in the midst of responding to the coronavirus ("COVID-19") worldwide pandemic. Attending a SKUSA Event, as well as any sporting event at this time, could increase your risk of contracting COVID -19.

By signing this COVID-19 release agreement, I specifically acknowledge the unique and special COVID-19 related risks I am accepting by attending the SKUSA Event. **I UNDERSTAND THAT EXPOSURE TO COVID 19 COULD RESULT IN PHYSICAL HARM, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO PERSONAL INJURY, ILLNESS, PERMANENT DISABILITY, AND DEATH.** I acknowledge that the risk of being exposed to the virus may originate from any and all persons who attend this event, including the SKUSA staff, teams, participants, mechanics, and participants' families.

I understand and agree that this release includes any claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence (gross or ordinary) of SKUSA, their employees, agents, and representatives whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after any SKUSA Event.

In addition, I freely accept all responsibility and the risks of any personal harm (including, but not limited to personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind that may result from attendance at the SKUSA Event. I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, indemnify, and hold harmless SuperKartsUSA and its employees, agents, and representatives, of and from any claims, including all liabilities, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto.

If any of the above statements are not true during a SKUSA event, I will inform an official SKUSA representative and take any corrective steps. I understand the risks that may occur while attending this SKUSA Event despite SKUSA taking all reasonable actions.

By signing this agreement, I accept all responsibility in the event that I am exposed to any illness, knowing that I am solely here by personal choice. I have read and understood the COVID-19 Protocol given to me by the SKUSA officials and agree to follow all recommendations per the local, state, and federal laws and ordinances while participating in this event.
